Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the City of Mission, Foxridge Drive Phase II Roadway Improvements in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Mission, located at 6090 Woodson St. Mission, Kansas 66202. The funding would be used for proposed improvements, which include full depth pavement reconstruction (pavement removal and replacement with a 10-inch asphaltic concrete base and 2-inch asphaltic concrete surface); replacement of curb and gutter; new sidewalks, streetlights, and stormwater infrastructure; and pavement markings. An underdrain system will be installed to address the stormwater runoff and pedestrian improvements will be made to create a more inviting, walkable environment. The traffic signal at the Foxridge to Lamar intersection will also be replaced and relocated improving access to Interstate Highway 35 (I-35) for both commercial and personal vehicles. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these improvements will enhance safety for drivers, pedestrians and cyclists traveling through the Foxridge corridor.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
