I am requesting funding for the Kansas State University Olathe Advanced Manufacturing and Supply Chain Research project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Kansas State University, located at 919 Mid-Campus Dr., Manhattan, KS, 66506.

The funding would be used to purchase equipment for the new labs that will support students and faculty research. The smart manufacturing lab areas include robotics and automation; mechanical; raw materials and bulk solids; and food manufacturing.
