Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Prairie Village Municipal Complex Improvements in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Prairie Village, located at 7700 Mission Road, Prairie Village, Kansas, 66208. The funding would be used for site work related to the project, but not a part of the building proper, which includes pavement for driveways, concrete sidewalk and curbs, underground detention, drainage pipes, fencing, pavement markings, landscaping, retaining walls, covered car ports, and utilities (electrical, water, gas, communications and waste water). The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will benefit all City of Prairie Village residents by giving them access to city facilities with modern meeting spaces, amenities, accessibility, and community facilities. It is a priority because existing facilities are aging and not meeting modern safety expectations. The existing facilities also do not meet modern programming requirements for community spaces or employee needs.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
