The National Park Service is pleased to provide you with the following information on a Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) grant award that is ready for public release.

The LWCF State and Local Assistance Program provides matching grants for state, tribe, and local park projects outside national park boundaries. LWCF grants are locally determined and competed at the state level through a process designed and managed by our state partners. These grants help build and protect a "seamless system of parks" from back-yard to back-country.

Since 1965, the National Park Service has provided more than 48,000 LWCF grants to states and local communities. LWCF funding is separate from NPS operational appropriations and comes primarily from offshore oil lease revenue permanently authorized under the Great American Outdoors Act of 2020.

Project Details

The recipient, the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks, will pass through a subaward/subgrant to the subrecipient, the City of Roeland Park, to improve Nall Park. This project will: construct a mountain bike trail, a beginner trail, a pump track, a playground, sidewalks and trails, retaining walls, a new shelter, and a gravel access road; install safety surfacing, a concrete pad, a shade structure, a bike repair station, signage and wayfinding elements, landscaping, and site amenities; and renovate an existing shelter and restroom facility.
